



FINAL NATIONALS UPDATE

Friday

- Registration begins at 9am at the Tourist Information Centre at the Railway Station on Hovell Street
- Registration continues until 7pm
- *The Ex Services Club are offering a special deal for Friday Lunch. You will find a voucher in your entrants bag.*
- *Commemorative Pontiac Nationals 2007 Beer / Soft Drink Mugs are available for \$5 with a fill of beer or soft drink at the Ex Services Club. Limited number available. First in Best Dressed.*
- The Cootamundra Drive Inn opens at 7:00pm for an 8pm start.



Saturday

- Scruteneering begins at 7:30am for those that are up early. **Judging will be done at Fisher Park. This will give everyone a bit more time to detail their cars.** Marshalling for the Street Parade begins at 10:30am. You would have been given a numbered label in your entrants bag along with your Entrants windscreen label. If not please see an official at the scruteneering. This number is the position your car will take in the street parade. The Street Parade will be in year & model order.
- Drivers Briefing begins at 11:30 am. Please listen carefully to any instruction given. As the parade is on public streets you will be required to follow the directions the Marshals will give you around the parade route.
- Street Parade begins at 12:00pm. Please leave in an orderly fashion. The Street Parade will finish up in Fisher Park. When entering Fisher Park please follow the directions that the Marshals will give you to parking your car. Please leave at least 1 car width (or enough room to open your doors). Once all cars are parked inside the park No Vehicles will be allowed to moved until 5pm!
- Judging will commence when all cars are

parked in Fisher Park. Your window sticker will be marked once your car has been judged.

- 6pm brings us to Saturday nights entertainment at the Ex Services Club in Parker St. With Luke O'Shea & his band performing and a comedian to keep us entertained for the night. Raffle Tickets will be on sale during the night. The prize is a trip for 2 to NZ for the week including Campervan to cruise the land of the long white cloud at your leisure. Tickets are \$10 each. *Those people that have notified us of their special dietary requirements please show your Nat's ID that you would have been in your Entrants bag to the person serving you.* You will be treated to a wonderful 2 course dinner. Drinks can be purchased at the Club. Remember when leaving the club be respectful of the neighbors & leave quietly. A shuttle bus will be provided for entrants leaving the club. The bus will leave every 15 minutes & will visit the motels & caravan park before returning to the club.



Sunday

- Sprints....

to the sprints track. All other entrants cars should be parked in the Airport car park or in the roped off area inside the airport gates. Spectators cars can only be parked in the Airport car park. Remember this is an Alcohol Free event!

- Sprints will finish at 3:30pm sharp as the airport will be opened back up to air traffic at 4pm. All cars are to exit the airport runway area at this time.
- For those that are not entering the sprints a bus will be leaving from the Airport for a local tour returning to the Airport at 3:30pm.

You will find a ticket in your goodies bag. The main feature will be the 1971 car cult classic Two Lane Black Top starring Dennis Wilson (The Beach Boys), Warren Oats (Stripes), 71 GTO & a 55 Chev. Hotdogs, Pop Corn, Fish Burgers, Hamburgers, Soft Drinks etc will be available for purchase at the venue. **A \$5 voucher is included in your entrants bag to go towards a purchase from the food van on site.** This is a family night so no alcohol will be allowed into the "Drive Inn". The Coota Drive Inn is situated for one night in the car park of the Cootamundra Airport on Jack Masling Drive (Northern end of town). Please be considerate of our neighbors & keep noise to a minimum when arriving or leaving the Drive Inn.

Judging will commence once all entrants cars are parked at Fisher Park. Members of the local car club will be judging the entrants cars. Members of the P.C.C.A. Inc. will be on hand to aid the judges. The Judges will be split into teams covering paint/ exterior, interior/boot, engine bay. If not already done you can nominate your car as either Standard or Modified. If in doubt please talk to a P.C.C.A. official for clarification. Once judged you can't change your classification. Once Judged, your window label will be marked.

Scruteneering

If you have nominated that your car will be competing in the Sprints on Sunday you will have to have your car scruteneered. Your car will be checked by a qualified person for safety. Items like Seatbelts, Fire Extinguisher, Battery Mount, Tyres etc will be checked. You will be also asked if you have or are able to acquire a Helmet for the sprints. Once checked, your window label will be marked.

Street Parade

- Vehicle Marshaling will begin at 10:30am. A drivers briefing will be held at 11:30 am.

- When entering Fisher Park please follow the direction of Nat's Officials in positioning of your car. Once parked you won't be able to move your car until 5pm.
- Carnival rides & attractions will be in the asphalt area. Spectators will be asked for a gold coin donation to enter Fisher Park to go to a local service club.

You will find a map printed on the opposite page detailing places like Fisher Park, Registration, Judging, Scruteneering, Services Club, Airport & Drive Inn. A copy of this map will be on the back of your Nat's program that you will find in your goodies bag. Don't loose it & treat it like gold. It will also have important phone numbers in it to assist you during your weekend.
