The Pontiac Nationals is coming to Cootamundra.

The Pontiac Car Club of Australia Inc is holding it's bi annual show this year in the township of Cootamundra NSW over the Easter weekend 2007.

If you are a non entrant & would like to come along please bring your chair, a blanket & an FM radio as space for entrants cars is limited.

You may be able to see anything from a 1926 Pontiac through to 2002 Pontiac Trans Am Firehawk Convertible & just about everything in between. Many would remember the Parisienne & Laurentian of the 60's. You will be able to see these & more at the Street Parade & Show & Shine that will be held on **Saturday the 7th of April**. Come & enjoy a fun filled day with plenty of rides & things to do & see. Markets will also be held at Fisher Park during the Show & Shine.

On **Sunday the 8th of April** the Pontiac Car Club of Australia Inc. is holding a timed sprint event over a 1/8th mile. This event is open to P.C.C.A. members and members of the local public that wish to enter their cars. For locals wishing to enter their car a fee of \$40 is required. You will then become a member of the P.C.C.A. Inc. for 12 months & be able to compete in the sprint event. A drivers briefing will be held for those locals that wish to compete prior to the event. Trophies will be awarded for best reaction time, closest to dial in time & fastest of the day. This, as with any event involving moving vehicles, is an alcohol free event. Breath testing will be performed at the start of the sprints event.
